CHARGING AND REMISSIONS POLICY

The Governing Board have historically adopted Havering Council charging and Remission Policy.

Music Tuition

All music tuition is now organised by the Havering Music School. Pupil Premium is used to support parents of children who are eligible.

Materials and Ingredients

Schools are required to provide or pay for any ingredients, materials or equipment needed for practical subjects such as cookery or technology. At Parklands Junior parents indicate in advance if they wish to own the finished product and send in the money to cover the cost of the materials.

Cookery - children will bring their own ingredients for the session.

Technology - either a small charge is levied to cover the cost of materials or object is dismantled to reuse materials.

Residential Trips

Each year an extended school trip is organised for those children in Year 6 whose parents would like them to be included.

Parents cover the cost of accommodation, transport and activities. Pupil Premium is used to support parents of children who are eligible.

School Trips

There is an exception to the rule about not charging for activities in school hours. Parents may be invited to make voluntary contributions to extend the value of school funds. The following paragraph is included in all letters sent to parents requesting contributions to school activities.

'Under the regulations from the Government, these contributions are voluntary and no child would be omitted from the activity if his or her parents are unable or unwilling to make a contribution. However, if we are unable to cover the cost of the visit then we will have to cancel.'

All trips are costed well in advance with an amount being charged that will not result in a profit being made.

A record is kept of the amount of money that has been collected for each trip.

Pupil Premium is used to support parents of children who are eligible.

Breakfast/After School Clubs

The School will charge parents for these services, out of school hours, and the scale of charges will be approved by the Governing Board on an annual basis.

Scale of Charges

These will be approved by the Governing Board on an annual basis.

Charges Schedule

£3 per session

£30 per term

Extra curricular clubs provided by school

£5 per day

Breakfast club from external provider

£4 per session

Football club from external provider

£2 per session

Lunchtime clubs from external provider

There is no charge for swimming as this is funded from school budget.
